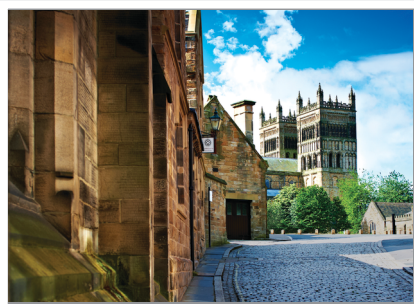

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS FROM BRAZIL

GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Foundation	Students that have completed the Certificado de Ensino Médio with a GPA of 7.0 or better will be considered for entry to courses within the Foundation Centre. IELTS 6.0 or above with no element below 5.5 (or recognised equivalent). (exceptions are foundation programmes for Law
Undergraduate	International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma: 34-38 points GCE A Levels (ABB - A*A*A) A recognised UK foundation programme IELTS (or recognised equivalent) at 6.5 with no element below 6.0 (exceptions are Law (M101) and Pharmacy (B230) which require IELTS 7 with no element below 6.5).
Postgraduate taught	A Bacharel or Licenciado (4 years or more) with a GPA of 8 or better would be considered for postgraduate taught programmes
Postgraduate research	Students that have successfully completed the Mestrado qualification in Brazil would be considered for entry to postgraduate research programmes at Durham University. IELTS 6.5 - 7.0 with no element below 6.0 (or recognised

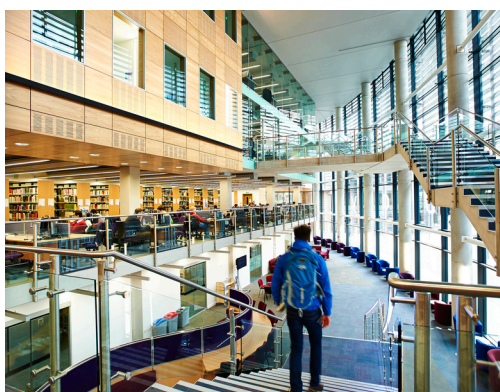
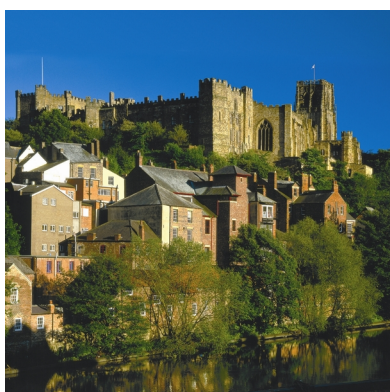
SCIENCE WITHOUT BORDERS
