

UAL International Summer School 2014 6 - 24 July 2015

The UAL International Summer School is a residential programme, designed to give 16 – 18 year old international students who are studying A Level/International Baccalaureate or students with equivalent art and design experience an introduction to art college, and is similar to the structure of an Art Foundation Diploma course.

As in Foundation Studies, students will follow a studio/location based course that will help build their portfolios and develop the necessary knowledge and practical skills for their A Level/IB submissions. It also offers a unique opportunity to explore London's rich heritage and social diversity through art and design projects.

Our Summer School takes place across the University of The Arts London's six Colleges in various locations around London. These are Camberwell College of Arts, Chelsea College of Arts, Central Saint Martins, London College of Fashion and Wimbledon College of Arts.

By the end of three weeks, students will have generated a range of work and experimented with scale, texture and colour via the mediums of drawing, sketching, mark-making, photography, 2D and 3D collage and modelling.

Course location The course takes place at workshops at UAL's six Colleges in various locations around London. Accommodation is in Passfield Hall of Residence in central London.

Who can apply? 16 to 18 year old international students who are studying the IB or equivalent.
